Retinal Photography (Children & seniors exams only – service is included in adult exams)

Anterior Eye Photography

Slit Lamp Anterior Segment Photography is used to document microscopic and obscure details of the transparent, translucent and opaque structures of the anterior segment and surrounding areas of the eye. Different lenses, drops, and filters can all be used to highlight and magnify any problem areas in the front of the eye including the eyelids, conjunctiva, iris, lens, sclera and cornea.

Meibography

Ophthalmic imaging device to capture digital images of the meibomian glands. 86% of those diagnosed with Dry Eye have symptoms caused by meibomian gland dysfunction (MGD). This can tell how many of your glands are still functioning and how many are at risk of atrophy because of too much oil clogging the opening of the gland. This is a valuable tool to guide your dry eye treatment.
